WHO WE ARE

Good Neighbors Home Repair restores hope and dignity to qualified low income homeowners by repairing their homes at no cost. We have been serving Chester County, PA since 1992 and expanded into New Castle County, DE in 2016. By the end of 2018 we expect to repair a total of 140 homes!

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

HOURS

Volunteer groups can sign up for half-day, full day or multiple day time slots.

LOCATION

Work sites will be at various low income homes along the Route 9 Corridor in New Castle. Specific addresses will be made available closer to the event.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers tasks will include light construction, painting or light carpentry work. No experience or specific skills are required. All work sites are led and supervised by licensed and trained project managers from Good Neighbors Home Repair.

ATTIRE

Work clothes and closed toe shoes. Be prepared to be outside.

NUMBER OF VOLUNTEERS

Needed: 8-10 volunteers will be assigned to an individual home during a designated time slot. If you are an individual or if you have a group smaller than 8, we will pair you with another team. Each group will need a designated team captain.
